




DICASTERY FOR THE CLERGY

- a time for **their own priestly formation** and for **formation for the service of vocations and of the Clergy**;

PLACE and TIME

The lectures – fully compatible with the schedule of the Licentiate and Doctorate studies in the various Roman universities – will be held in Italian from October 2022 through the end of May 2023, at the office of the Dicastery for the Clergy (Piazza Pio XII, 3 – 2nd floor).

The course may be taken every Thursday during the academic year in either one of two sessions:

Group B: 17:10 to 18:25 (beginning 13 October)

The course will also include four Saturdays, from 09:00 to 13:00.

REGISTRATION

Seats are limited; Priests are invited to register as soon as possible in order to have the certainty of being able to participate.

Registration is made directly to the Dicastery for the Clergy and must include:

- a letter of recommendation from the Priest's proper Ordinary or the Rector of a Pontifical College, addressed to His Eminence, Lazzaro Cardinal YOU HEUNG SIK, Prefect of the Dicastery for the Clergy;
- documentation regarding studies already completed or a certificate of matriculation in courses in a Pontifical or other university at the licentiate level or above;
- one passport photo;
- the annual registration fee of €100.
