# AN INTERNATIONAL MEETING FOR DEACONS IN THE CONTEXT OF THE JUBILEE 2025

On the occasion of the Jubilee of Deacons (February 21-23, 2025), the Dicastery for the Clergy announces an International Meeting titled "Deacons in a Synodal and Missionary Church: Witnesses of Hope." This event aims to provide a space for reflection and sharing among Bishops, Delegates, and Representatives of Episcopal Conferences and Dioceses, as well as Deacons and their spouses, to deepen the role and mission of the permanent diaconate in today's Church.

The meeting will take place on the morning of Saturday, February 22, 2025, at the Auditorium Conciliazione and will serve as an opportunity for mutual listening on the ministry of the diaconate in the context of synodality and mission. Participation is free of charge, but mandatory registration is required through the official website of the Dicastery for the Clergy (clerus.va) until capacity is reached.

The event will open with a prayer and the institutional greetings of Cardinal Lazzaro You Heung Sik, Prefect of the Dicastery for the Clergy, and Monsignor Andrés Gabriel Ferrada Moreira, Secretary of the Dicastery. Following this, a series of testimonies from various parts of the world will offer a snapshot of the reality of the diaconate in different ecclesial contexts, highlighting the challenges and opportunities of this ministry today.

After a brief break, Prof. Serena Noceti will lead a theological reflection on the diaconate in a synodal and missionary Church, helping participants to consider how the diaconal service can increasingly be a sign of hope for the people of God. Subsequently, Rev. Prof. Dario Vitali will present a framework for updating the *Ratio Formationis* and the Directory for the Ministry and Life of Permanent Deacons (which date back to 1998), offering perspectives for the future of the diaconal vocation.

The concluding moment will feature interventions from the Superiors of the Dicastery, who will present the launch of a global online consultation on the ministry of the diaconate, inviting participants to contribute to the ecclesial reflection on this particular vocation.

The pilgrimage to the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica, led by the Dicastery for the Clergy, will mark the culmination of the meeting—a deeply spiritual moment of prayer and unity for all participants.
